## GENERAL ACADEMIC INFORMATION

### Minimum Minor Requirements

- 9 credit hours
- 2.5 Minor GPA; all courses must have a grade of C- or better.
- Residency: All 9 credit hours of the minor must be completed while registered at UCCS.

**NOTE:** Speak with an academic advisor in Main Hall, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, to declare a minor.
