## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

UCCS does not have an occupational therapy program. Pre-Occupational Therapy Prep is not a major or a minor, but a listing of prerequisite courses and recommendations needed to be eligible for admission into CSU's College of Health and Human Services in Ft. Collins, CO. A bachelor's degree with a minimum of 120 credits from an accredited institution is required to be completed prior to matriculation to the program.

Other programs may have different requirements. Students should check admissions requirements for all schools to which they plan to apply. Completion of prerequisite coursework does not guarantee acceptance into any professional degree.
