## GENERAL INFORMATION

UCCS **does not** have a pharmacy program. **Pre-Pharmacy Prep** is **not** a major or a minor, but a listing of prerequisite courses and recommendations needed to be eligible for admission into CU Skaggs School of Pharmacy & Pharmaceutical Sciences at the Anschutz Medical Campus in Aurora, CO. A college program leading to a bachelor's degree generally strengthens a student's application to the program. Students in the pre-Pharmacy program are advised to choose a major and should plan to graduate with a bachelor's degree from UCCS.

Other programs may have different requirements. Students should check admissions requirements for all schools to which they plan to apply. Completion of prerequisite coursework does not guarantee acceptance into any professional degree.
