GENERAL INFORMATION

UCCS does not have a physical therapy program. Pre-Physical Therapy Prep is not a major or a minor, but a listing of prerequisite courses and recommendations needed to be eligible for admission into CU School of Medicine's Physical Therapy program at the Anschutz Medical Campus in Aurora, CO. A bachelor's degree (BS or BA) requiring at least 120 credits, in a field other than physical therapy, must be completed prior to matriculation into the professional program.

Other schools may have different requirements so students should check admissions requirements for all schools to which they plan on applying. Completion of prerequisite coursework does not guarantee acceptance into any professional degree.
