- 3. 2.0 CU cumulative GPA
- Residency: Last 30 credit hours of degree must be completed while registered in the College of Education at UCCS.

The Human Services profession is one that promotes improved service delivery systems by addressing not only the quality of direct services, but also by seeking to improve accessibility, accountability, and coordination among professionals and agencies in service delivery. Services are provided during prevention, intervention, and remediation phases depending upon the goals of a particular organization.
