## GENERAL INFORMATION

UCCS **does not** have a Pre-Child Health Associate/Physician Assistant (CHA/PA) program. **Pre-Child Health Associate/Physician Assistant Prep** is **not** a major or a minor, but a listing of prerequisite courses and recommendations needed to be eligible for admission to the CU School of Medicine's CHA/PA program at the Anschutz Medical Campus in Aurora, CO. **A bachelor's degree with a minimum of 120 credits from an accredited institution is required to be completed prior to matriculation to the program.**

Other schools may have different requirements so students should check admissions requirements for all schools to which they plan on applying. Completion of prerequisite coursework does not guarantee acceptance into any professional degree.
